Tom Chapman Civil Engineering Scholarship

The Tom Chapman Civil Engineering Scholarship was established to provide financial assistance to SDSU students who are pursuing careers as a civil engineer. The scholarship is intended for students who would not be able to continue their education without it.

Tom Chapman Civil Engineering Scholarship applicants should:

- Reside in San Diego County
- Be a current undergraduate at San Diego State University who has completed at least one academic year
- Major in Civil Engineering
- Be involved in serving their community as demonstrated by extra-curricular activities, community and/or church service and work experience
- Have a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale
- Have a demonstrated financial need
- Be United States citizens
- Special consideration will be given to students focusing on construction materials and/or geo-technical coursework
