A reminder to our students about meeting with your program adviser: you are required to have a **Master Plan** on file with CCEE and the evaluations department in order to graduate. The reason why is so you can select your professional electives and met with an adviser before you finish your program. You should have this plan on file when you reach your Junior year. The Master Plan is also required in order to take specific upper level classes that have been restricted by the department. In order to register for these classes (for example: Capstone) you will need to have your Master Plan on file, your prerequisites complete, and to contact the department in order to receive the code to register for the class.
